Key Skills	<u>English</u> Read a book or several chapters every week	<u>English</u> Write a daily diary entry as a WW1 soldier living in the trenches	<u>Maths</u> Collect data and organise it into different types of graphs and charts	<u>Maths</u> Practise your times tables and division facts at least twice a week

Why was he important to the start of WW1. Find out other reasons for why WW1 happened.
	<u>Research</u> Which were the main countries involved in WW1? List them and find them on a map.	<u>Literacy</u> Choose a character from a programme , film or book you know well and write a character profile (as we will do in class).	<u>Get Creative</u> Look up a wartime Rock Bun recipe and make it for your family.	<u>Get creative</u> Look up Eden Camp- persuade me that we should go there. Use effective reasoning skills.
	<u>Research</u> Watch-Diet Coke and Mentos Rocket: The Best Way on Youtube- Write an explanation of what happened (Do not try it yourself as it can be dangerous!)	<u>Literacy/ICT</u> Create a Powerpoint about any aspect of WW1 that you find particularly interesting. Show it to the class.	<u>Get Creative</u> Decide on any new skill you'd like to develop e.g. riding a bike, swimming, keepy- ups with a football, plaiting, learning a tune on an instrument and practise until you improve.Keep a record.	<u>Research</u> Who were Rama and Sita? What is their story? Find out and draw pictures of Hanuman and Ravanna.
