Literacy- we will be covering a wide range of texts including information books and posters, instructions and recounts. We will still be having a large focus on handwriting, phonics and our sentence structure all within the context of the Great Fire of London.

History - our topic is the Great
Fire of London, we will be looking
at how it started and why it is a
significant event in history. We
will also be visiting the National
Emergency Services Museum to
enhance our learning.

Music-We will be learning two songs, comparing these songs and others and doing a variety of vocal warm up activities.

Maths-first we will be focusing on measurement particularly height and length, comparing and describing it. We will move on to multiplication counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and division where we will be looking at sharing amounts equally. Finally, we will look at fractions focusing on halves and quarters.

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'The great fire of London'

Science- our topic is reuse and recycle. We will be looking at the definitions of these words and understanding what can be recycled and reused and the benefits of this.

R.E- we will be looking at the celebration of Easter and new life.

Art/DT - we will be using collage and paint to create scenes from the Great Fire of London and different resources to create the houses, boats and fire engines from this time.

P.E has a focus on composition, we will have a dance teacher coming in on a Tuesday.
