Literacy

The focus is on myths and legends, in particular the stories of Romulus and Remus and Escape from Pompeii; and writing instructions.

Art

We will be creating mosaics and designing and making a Roman shield.

Science

Living thing; and their habitat;

Explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name living things in our local and wider environment.

Maths

- Reinforce the place value of 3, 4 and 5 digit numbers— add and subtract 1000 mentally
- Know how to round numbers to estimate calculations mentally
- Reinforce calculation methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division—explain how you use your methods and why
- Reinforce all times and division facts what are the divisibility rules for each
