


Dear Parents and Carers,

The School Age Immunisation Team will be visiting schools from September 2025 to give the **Seasonal Flu Vaccine** to children. **A single dose of the flu nasal spray will mean your child is less likely to become ill if they come into contact with the flu virus.**

	<p><b>We need your consent to give your child the vaccine.</b> When filling in the consent form, you will have <b>3 options</b>:</p>
	<p>1. <b>Nasal spray</b>- This is the most effective way to protect your child from flu. (Please note: it contains pork gelatine.)</p>
	<p>2. <b>Injectable flu vaccine</b> - This version <b>does not</b> contain pork gelatine.</p>
	<p>3. <b>To not give consent</b></p>
