Dear Parents and Carers,

Y6 Residential Visit to Thornbridge Outdoors – Wednesday 1st July – Friday 3rd July

We are excited to announce that we are arranging a two night residential trip to Thornbridge Outdoors in Derbyshire for our Y6 pupils. We are very pleased to have secured the booking as it is an extremely popular venue with school groups.

For parents who are new to Thornbridge, they are a well-respected, local residential activity centre provider, responsible for delivering safe and rewarding educational programmes to children every year. By combining both indoor and outdoor adventure activities, this trip is sure to provide your child with a wealth of new experiences outside of the classroom while developing key learning outcomes. Residential courses organised by schools are an optional but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Pupils benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially.

The trip will take place from **Wednesday 1st July to Friday 3rd July**. The cost of the visit will be **£170** and includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities. To secure a place on this residential, a **£40 deposit** will need to be paid via Parent Pay by **Friday 19th December**. Monthly instalments can be made after this (for example £22 in January, February, March, April, May and June).

We would like to encourage as many Y6 pupils as possible to attend and understand that you may have a number of questions about the arrangements for the residential and what it involves. If you are considering allowing your child to attend or would like more information, then please do come along to a short presentation in school at **3.30 pm on Tuesday 23rd September** which will explain about the residential and give you an opportunity to ask questions.
